Have you thought that you could lose your license? pay a large fine? go to jail?

If you are convicted of driving while intoxicated (DWI), you will face penalties. These penalties are set by state laws.

- Fines: You might have to pay a fine. In some states the fine is more than \$500.
- Loss of license: The state might take away your driving license. You could lose your license for six months or a year or more.
- Jail: You might be sent to jail. Most important, you could hurt or kill yourself or someone else.

Drunken drivers cause many accidents. Alcohol takes away your driving skills. It:

- · slows your reaction time,
- · reduces your ability to see clearly,



- · distorts your ability to judge speeds and distances, and
- · makes you less alert.

Remember, drinking more than one drink per hour will cause your blood alcohol content to rise. Your driving skills will be reduced.

Be safe. Don't drink and drive.
